Language Proficiency Policy

Since all lectures and laboratories at Pull Focus are conducted in English, it is essential that all students possess strong writing, comprehension and speaking skills in English.

If an applicant's primary language is not English, they must provide proof of successful completion, or test scores from any of the following:

International Standardized Test Scores

- TOEFL- score of 68 internet-based (ibT), or 520 paper-based (PBT)
- TOEIC- score of 700
- Cambridge ACE-completion of any level, or FCE (First Certificate in English) Grade C
- IELTS Band 6.0- Academic Level
- LPI-Level 4

Applicants who have completed their high school education and/or two years of post-secondary where English was the main language of instruction can meet the English Proficiency Requirement through submission of transcripts from their high school and/or college.

Language Upgrading

If a student meets the Pull Focus Admission requirements, but does not have an acceptable English proficiency test score, the student still has several options for language upgrading.

Pull Focus has joint programs with Language-Education partners to assist students in meeting English Language requirements. Students can study English full-time until they achieve the necessary level of English proficiency, and then transition directly into the diploma program without completing the exam.
