OUR HISTORY


10 YEARS OF SUCCESS

Our students' success has grown with us, and many have gone on to win major awards, receive grants and project funding, and make the selection at prestigious festivals, right out of school.


With 10 years of results behind us, we're excited to see what the next 10 years will bring.

PROGRAM LENGTH 10 MONTHS

CREDETIAL DIPLOMA

The 3D Animation and Visual Effects Program prepares students for an exciting career in the visual effects industry. InFocus VFX instructors are industry professionals who deliver interactive lectures in a creative, project-based learning environment. Small class sizes put an emphasis on individual attention. Each student completes multiple projects, building a show-reel designed to gain employment in large and small VFX and 3D animation studios.

Studios are looking for VFX artists who can go beyond button pushing to find creative solutions when facing unique challenges. InFocus students enter the job market with the expertise to succeed in Vancouver's vibrant VFX scene.



BECOME A SKILLED VFX ARTIST

TERM 1

This term introduces you to the fundamentals of everything being covered throughout the program. You will see the broad spectrum and endless possibilities contained within the world of 3D and VFX. Acquiring knowledge in design as well as storytelling, you will complete a series of 3D based projects using techniques and workflows that are currently used in the industry, preparing you for advancement in Term 2.

TERM 2


After receiving a basic understanding of 3D Animation and Visual Effects, you will deepen your knowledge by taking on bigger projects, learning advanced concepts, and choosing a key focus of either animation, 3D modelling, or VFX compositing. You will also begin to develop your demo reel, implementing ideas and concepts that will guide you towards your ideal industry career path.

TERM 3

This final stretch will allow you to focus on the production of your demo reel. You have learned the basics, advanced your knowledge, and covered a multitude of different techniques, programs, and cinematic styles to help build the perfect reel to take into the workforce. As always, our industry professional instructors will be there to lead you every step of the way.









WRITING FOR FILM + TELEVISION PROGRAM

Create an original TV pilot and a low-budget feature screenplay. Write a short film script and adapt an existing story for the screen. In a simulated writers' room, collaborate with other students to write a web series to be produced during the program. On the business side, become knowledgeable about all stages of film production, which will help inform your writing.

Upon completion, you will have screenwriting skill, pitching know-how, a solid portfolio and a strong resume which will open the doors to the industry.

COMPOSITING FOR VISUAL EFFECTS PROGRAM

InFocus Film School's Compositing for Visual Effects Program prepares you for an exciting career in the VFX industry. In just 20 weeks master the art of visual effects compositing and create a strong demo reel designed to catch the attention of VFX studios.

During this intense program, you will learn rotoscoping, camera stabilization techniques, green screen keying, and advanced 3D compositing in Nuke, the industry standard for compositing software. Skills are cemented through intensive projects involving roto, green screen elements, camera tracking and stabilization, dynamic effects and more.

PROGRAM CONTENT

3D COMPOSITING IN NUKE

Compositing is the art of combining visual elements into a single image. It is the most common type of visual effect, and Nuke is the industry standard compositing software.

ROTOSCOPY AND ROTOPAINT

Rotoscoping is the creation of mattes for elements on a live-action plate, preparing it to be composited over another background. RotoPaint is a tool that helps with rig and object removal, and more advanced rotoscoping

GREEN SCREEN KEYING

Green screens (or blue screens) are used to insert background elements into a live action shot. Whether characters are on an alien world or just on a rooftop, green screens are ubiquitous in film.

CAMERA TRACKING

Camera tracking, or match moving, is a technique that allows the insertion of computer graphics into live-action footage with correct position, scale, orientation, and motion, creating a believable finished shot.





GRAPHIC + DIGITAL DESIGN PROGRAM

Master the fundamentals of graphic design for web, print, and marketing in the digital age. The Graphic and Digital Design Program offers intensive training in industry standard software such as Adobe Photoshop, InDesign, and Illustrator to build a foundation of skills for your creativity to play on.

But industry professionals need more than artistic ability. Learn how to work with clients in a real-world setting and how to implement their business goals in your marketing and designs. The program also covers how to network, pitch your value, run campaigns, and showcase a tailored portfolio

FULL TIME PROGRAM PART TIME HOURS

Classes run Thursday, Friday, and Saturday for a total of 20 hours of instruction per week. A three-day school week frees time for you to work a part-time job, build your skills, make industry contacts, or simply relax in beautiful Vancouver.

A WORD FROM OUR FOUNDER

In January of 2010, InFocus opened its doors to the public. Now, nearly a decade on, InFocus is known for its intensely creative, project-based, career-focused programs. With attention to both the technical and creative, its passionate educators help students achieve mastery in their discipline. I started to work in film professionally in 1999 after spending several years working in a family business. It was a great career shift: directing films, travelling to festivals and meeting many creative people. Not only did I enjoy the work, but I loved the sense of collaboration with fellow artists and the sense of community. I grew up in an era when if you announced to your parents that you wanted to work in the arts, they would worry you would starve. But what my parents hadn't considered was the rise of well paid, film-related jobs around the world. In 2018, we saw over 450 productions generate \$3.4 billion for the BC economy.

In 2006, I was an Artist in Residence at the Canadian Film Centre in Toronto, founded by Norman Jewison. It is Canada's equivalent to Robert Redford's highly respected Sundance Institute. The year I spent at the CFC inspired me to establish an institute of similar caliber on the West Coast. With an eye towards excellence, InFocus seeks dedicated students who are eager to take artistic risks and give 110 percent throughout their many projects. Our educators and advisory boards are all film industry professionals who deliver a curriculum that is relevant to today's job market and at the same time, they nurture the independent film spirit. Our class sizes are deliberately small; Many of our alumni refer to us as their InFocus family.

It has been immensely gratifying to be a part of the journeys of filmmakers, writers, and visual effects artists. My favourite day of the year is graduation day when I see all the students' hard work celebrated in front of a live audience. It's a momentous day and a huge milestone. I have seen hundreds of students go from incredibly nervous beginners to budding professionals working in television production, on indie feature films and many on blockbuster films. It's been a pleasure to be part of their incredible journey.
