

# **TUITION REFUND POLICY**

Updated August 21, 2023

If a student withdraws, is dismissed, or is otherwise unable to attend their program, this policy lays out the circumstances in which a refund will be due to the student. Students will not be eligible for a refund in all circumstances, and, in the most common cases, only the tuition is refundable.

Refund calculations apply only to the tuition. Once due, all other fees will not be prorated and unless otherwise stated are non-refundable.

### **Notice of Withdrawal**

1. If a student wishes to cease study at InFocus Film School, to be considered for a refund, they must submit a written notice of withdrawal to InFocus Film School by mail, email, or hand delivery. Non-attendance alone does not constitute withdrawal.

### **Calculation of Hours**

- 2. If a student withdraws, refunds will be calculated based on the hours of instruction elapsed in the student's program of study up to the date the notice of withdrawal is received by InFocus Film School.
- If the student is dismissed from study, refunds will be calculated based on the hours of
  instruction elapsed in the student's program of study up to the date specified on the student's
  letter of dismissal.

## Scholarships and bursaries

4. Any scholarships, bursaries, or other discounts that may have been awarded to a student are considered void and forfeit if a student withdraws or is dismissed from their program of study, and will not be taken into account when determining tuition owed or due to be refunded.

5. Withdrawals before a program's start date If InFocus Film School receives a notice of withdrawal before the start date of the student's program of study, the following table shall be used to determine the student's refund. This applies to all programs, regardless of the method of delivery.

Fewer than 30 days before the program start date, determined by the later of:

- The program start date in the enrollment contract, or
- ii. For international students, the program start in the most recent Letter of Acceptance delivered to the student.

InFocus Film School is owed and will retain 10% of the tuition due in the enrollment contract up to a maximum of \$1000.

InFocus Film School will refund the balance of any tuition paid, plus program fees including:

- Administrative fees
- Material and textbook fees
- Assessment fees

The application fee is non-refundable and shall be retained by InFocus Film School.

InFocus Film School is owed and will retain 20% of the tuition due in the enrollment contract up to a maximum of \$1300.

InFocus Film School will refund the balance of any tuition paid, plus program fees including:

- Administrative fees
- Material and textbook fees
- Assessment fees

The application fee is non-refundable and shall be retained by InFocus Film School.

6. Withdrawals after a program's start date (In-class and combined delivery)

For programs delivered in-class or through combined delivery, if InFocus Film School receives a notice of withdrawal or a student is dismissed after the program start date, the following table shall be used to determine the student's refund.

7. Withdrawals after a program's start date (distance delivery)
For programs delivered entirely through distance education, if InFocus Film School receives a notice of withdrawal or a student is dismissed after the program start date, the following table shall be used to determine the student's refund.

## 8. Refusal of study permit

If an international student requires a study permit, but receives a letter of denial and provides that letter to InFocus Film School, the following table shall be used to determine the student's refund, unless the student has requested an additional letter of acceptance for a later start date.

### 9. Other Refunds

The following table shall be used to determine if a student is owed a refund based on any other circumstances.

## **Damage and Key Deposits**

- 10. If a student has paid a key deposit, that deposit will be refunded to the student once the keys have been returned to InFocus Film School.
- 11. If a student has paid an equipment damage deposit, the damage deposit will be refunded to the student once they have completed or are otherwise no longer enrolled in the program, unless any of the following is true:
  - a. The student has not signed-in all equipment they have borrowed from InFocus Film School; or,
  - b. The student has damaged InFocus Film School's equipment or allowed InFocus Film School's equipment to become damaged while it was under the student's care, and has not made approved arrangements for its repair or replacement.

## **Issuance of Refunds**

12. Refunds due under this policy will be issued within 30 days of receiving a notice of withdrawal, receiving a copy of refusal of a study permit, or delivering a notice of dismissal to a student, as applicable.
